

OUTREACH REPORT -- Sunday, April 3, 2016, is Outreach Sunday. The collection will benefit, John, the South Sudanese child we sponsor. Any monetary donations will be placed in an escrow account for the 2017 school year expenses. In March, \$185 was collected for Grace House on the Mountain.
