IN LOVING MEMORY

On Sunday, September 10, 2017, the oldest life-long member of Saint Peter’s-in-the-Mountains congregation died. Estelle Elma Jones was born on January 11, 1922, was baptized on August 6, 1955 by the Reverend John Staunton, and confirmed on June 25, 1956 by the Right Reverend William Marmion.

Estelle attended the Phoebe Needles Mission school along with her siblings from 1930 to 1935, and went on to graduate from the Callaway High School.
