The theme for this year's grants is Becoming Beloved Community: Racial Healing, Reconciliation and Justice. Grace Episcopal Church in Lexington, VA, received \$46,905 to renovate the undercroft of the 1883 church to make a community room with spaces for various events that focus on developing healing relationships especially across racial lines.
