Stone Mission
Adults and Youth Invited



Founded in 2006, Stepping Stone Mission in Rocky Mount provides a daily hot meal, 7 days a week, to anyone in need. They serve 40 to 70 people per day between 11:30 and 12:45, weekends and holidays included. In addition, they make resource referrals to other community services.

Although not a food bank, the Mission also provides individuals with basic food staples. Their thrift store (Joanne's Place) helps fund the Mission and accepts donations of clothing and household items. To learn more, visit their website: <https://www.steppingstonemission.org/about>

On Monday, January 16, 9:00-12:30, St Peter's adults and youth are invited to volunteer at the Mission.
