

Organ Dedication Service

On Sunday, June 12, we will have a special service to dedicate the Johannes Organ at Saint Peter's. The purchase of the organ was made possible by the generous donations of many people in honor and memory of Erma Guilliams Custer who was the organist/church musician at Saint Peter's for many years.

The dedication will be woven into the worship service at 10:00 a.m. and will include a concert by Juanita (Nita) Smoot. Here is some information about our guest organist and the music she will be playing on June 12:

Nita received her Bachelor of Music degree from Belmont University in Nashville, TN. She spent two years as a Missionary Journeyman in Brazil, where she worked as an accompanist and music instructor at the South Brazilian Baptist Seminary.

Later, she earned a Master of Church Music/Organ Pedagogy degree from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky, and she received the 1983 Faculty Award in Church Music Education.


Throughout her music career, Nita has been involved in music education for preschool age children through adults in churches, studios, private and public schools and colleges.

Nita, now retired, resides in Henry, Virginia, on a farm which she shared with her late husband, Jim Wilson. She has two adult sons, Justin and Alexander Hamlin.

The music that has chosen for the dedication will incorporate organ music and hymns based on Galatians 5:22-23.
