Outreach Update

During the first quarter of 2023, our local outreach focused on Stepping Stone Mission in Rocky Mount. The Mission serves a hot meal daily, 365 days a year. Thank you to the many individuals who donated much needed paper supplies. These have been delivered and are greatly appreciated. In addition our youth volunteered several hours on a Saturday morning and a \$750 donation was made from our outreach budget. In addition, a contribution of \$742 was made to Episcopal Relief and Development specifically for earthquake relief. The amount was made up of individual contributions plus funds from St. Peter's outreach budget.

Phoebe Needles Center, Inc will be our outreach focus for April-June. Monetary donations will be collected at St. Peter's to be used to fund camp scholarships. There will be multiple opportunities across the quarter to contribute to hands-on projects of all skill levels for individuals, families and groups. Examples of needs at the Center: Weeding and landscaping, trail maintenance, small paint jobs, staining decks, porch repair, washing the PNC Bus and some more complex building repair. Sergeant Megan Huston of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office will present "Safe Seniors Franklin County."

Sgt. Huston will provide a brief overview of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office, including its resources and capabilities, its national accreditation, the Citizen's Academy, the Citizens on Patrol program, and the School Safety Initiative. She will also illustrate the current crime trends in Franklin County, educate participants on how they can protect themselves from scams, and provide personal safety tips for seniors.

Sgt. Megan Huston was born and raised in Lexington, VA. She graduated from Ferrum College in 2011 with Bachelor's Degrees in Psychology and Criminal Justice. She began her law enforcement career in 2012 at the Botetourt County Sheriff's Office, before coming to Franklin Co. in 2016. In Franklin Co., she worked in Corrections for eight years before being reassigned to her current position of Public Relations and Accreditation in 2020. She is in her eleventh year of law enforcement. Her regular duties include: managing the department's accreditation and policies, grant writing, managing the department's social media accounts, coordinating all media releases and interviews, and assisting the Sheriff with special projects. She lives in Glade Hill with her husband and 21-month old son.
